Boston Harbor Hotel

Boston, MA

Housed in the iconic Rowes Wharf, known as the “Gateway to Boston,” Boston Harbor Hotel is a landmark in its own right. The hotel effortlessly captures that classic New England elegance with dark, polished woods offset by light tones of creme and blue.
